## **Important Update For Parents/Carers**

You may notice some changes in the way the activities have been developed this half term. The Me Too funding has been available for a year, and has enabled us to support many children and families in the Bridlington area. As part of the development of the project we have consulted with all parties involved and responded accordingly. Due to the high demand and reduced budget and staffing for this year, we have had to make cutbacks to the number of activities we can offer; however, we have strived to ensure these meet the needs of local families.

This programme of activities is funded by the Me Too subsidy fund. The aim of the Me Too project is to enable children, who are eligible for free school meals or are part of the looked after system, to access 30 hours of holiday activities over the year, which works out at around 3 hours per holiday week. Therefore we have focused on shorter sessions, giving children access to a variety of options as opposed to providing full day care.

Please note we do not provide refreshments at any of the activities – please supply drinks (especially if the children are taking part in sporting activities).

Please ensure that suitable clothing is worn, and if the activity is outdoors please provide sun block as appropriate.

Note that activity providers cannot take responsibility for personal belongings.

Activities are open to all children and families although there are age restrictions on some events and all children 8 years and under must be accompanied by an adult. Some activities are for families therefore children will not be able to take part if not accompanied by an adult. We have endeavoured to provide the activities at the lowest possible price to ensure everyone can participate. **External funding has also been secured to enable children**

who receive free school meals the opportunity to take part for free\*. (Evidence of this may be required). **This extends to travel arrangements to and from the activities, please make this known when you book your place(s).**

Whilst every effort has been made to assess and check the safety of the activities, it is the parent/carers responsibility to check the suitability of the activity for their child.

If you are unable to attend an activity and you do not cancel beforehand this may jeopardize your opportunity of pre booking in the future. If your child is eligible for free school meals and they do not attend a pre booked activity, the time will be deducted from their allocation if notice of cancellation is not received.

## Details of Activities and Booking Information
